That mint is used extensively, in commercial horse feeds, but not in enough quantity to have any medicinal benefit



It is used as an additive in horse feeds to make the feed more appetising as it has a delightful aroma not only to us but to our equine friends also.



Fed as a supplement, (15- 20gms daily) this benefit can be extended to encouraging a sick horse or fussy feeder to eat. It can also aid to mask some medications such as phenbutalazone that may have been added to the feed.



Herbally, it is considered a fantastic digestive aid, soothing and relaxing the whole digestive tract, and has a mild antacid effect, helping with the problem of flatulence that some horses suffer from.



Because of the air they draw in, it is considered a good daily supplement for windsuckers/crib biters. Also many a horse have ceased "farting" when fed mint regularly.
